Programs, Outreach and Partnerships

Programs/Services

- In February, attendees at the Craft and Connect sessions learned how to use the Cricut Mug Press, a machine that applies ink designs onto ceramic mugs. In March, patrons will make a personalized treat jar for their pets. Lindsay and Fenelon Falls branches have many people on the waitlist to join this program. Staff are working on how to increase the number of sessions at these two locations.
- A **Mahjong** group has started to meet at Coboconk Branch. There is also a Scrabble group, an adult colouring group and a group of residents who regularly attend the monthly Craft and Connect Program.
- PA Day activities continued on February 28th at all Friday-open branches.
- All 100 special Take Home Packs for Family Day were distributed. These packs included a brochure listing five activities that KLPL recommends to do for Family Day (reading, playing a game, baking together as a family, etc.) along with some bonus items such as hot chocolate packs, and suggested books to check out from the library. On Saturday, February 16th, all branches also hosted a drop-in craft where participants were encouraged to create snowflakes out of washi tape and construction paper.
- Bobcaygeon had a successful **Dungeons and Dragons** game event in February.
- Staff are tabulating patron votes for the annual Readers Choice Awards and will announce winners in mid-March.

- Care Home visits continued in February with book exchanges at Aspira and Case Manor in Bobcaygeon, and at William Place, Frost Manor, and Caressant Care in Lindsay.
- The Happy Hour Book Club met at the Old Dog Brewery in Bobcaygeon. This book club is at full capacity.
- The **Pages and Pints Book** club met at the Olympia Restaurant in downtown Lindsay. This book club consistently has 10-11 people attended.
- The **Books and Brews** book club meets monthly at Murphy's Pub in Fenelon Falls. There are currently 14 members in this book club.
- Bobcaygeon staff hosted the first meeting of a book club at Kindred Coffee Bar in Bobcaygeon in February. This book club is already full with a waitlist of interested patrons.
- Library staff gave a presentation on library services, programs, accessibility, and volunteer opportunities, at the Community Care Diner's Club in Fenelon Falls and Burnt River. A total of 88 individuals were at this event.
- New story walk boards are in place at Ken Reid Conservation Area and Settlers Village.
- Library staff attended the **Love Your Local Authors** event on February 23rd, hosted by **The Olde Kirk Museum** located in Kirkfield, ON. Attendees were given a presentation on library services, programs and resources available.
