

Branch News

- **Coboconk branch** renovations are complete with a new public washroom area. The library branch has an improved service counter and now offers increased public space and new shelving. The branch reopened on July 2nd.
- **Lindsay Branch** will be closed from September 3-14 while carpet is replaced on the main floor. The Program department will be closed for a further two weeks to allow for a renovation to the shelving system of the juvenile collection and improved program delivery area. A pop up children's library will be offered in the latter half of September out of the Lindsay Meeting Room to allow for limited circulation of juvenile material and drop-in programs
- **Bethany branch** will be closed in October to allow for improvements to the ramp and entrances to that building.
- **New stand alone exterior book drops** are being purchased for Woodville and Bethany branches.

Programs, Outreach and Partnerships

Programs/Services

- Dunsford had 67 students for **class visits** in June.
- The Kinmount Branch **Seed Swap** is going well. Patrons are enjoying picking up new seeds for their gardens as well as advice from the Garden Club.
- The Dalton Branch started a **Beginners Sewing Workshop**.
- **Read to a Dog** - Two monthly visits at Lindsay branch with St. Johns Ambulance Therapy dog Boom and Kim (handler) started in May and have continued now into July.
- **Bad Art Night** had a strong showing in July with 23 participants.
- Some of the library events offered to honour **Pride celebration** (June 22-July 6)
 - Rainbow Bingo – This reading challenge sheet was created by the Rainbow Book Club members.
 - Pride Storytime hosted for preschoolers on July 2, 4, and 6 saw 85 participants in total.
 - On July 6 Lindsay branch hosted a Pride Cookie Decorating workshop
- Lindsay Reference department provided 19 **One-on-One Tech Sessions** in June and 17 in July.

Outreach

- The Library has a Storywalk at **The Grove Theatre** in Fenelon Falls during the July production of “Into the Woods” which follows a fractured fairy tale plot line. The Storywalk is a choose-your-own-adventure fairy tale book.
- Outreach staff attended the Bobcaygeon Farmer’s Market during that community’s **Welcome Back Summer** event on June 8th. As well staff attend the **Thursday Farmer Market** in Lindsay on a weekly basis to promote the libraries services, collections, and programs.
- Library staff attended **Pride in the Park** on July 12th at the Maryboro Lodge Museum in Fenelon Falls. Material promoting the library’s LGBTQA+2 reading materials, and the Lindsay Rainbow Book Club were available.
- Library staff hosted an **outdoor pop-up storytime** with Parks and Recreation waterfront rentals on July 9th at the Bobcaygeon Beach for some beach story and a water safety talk provided by Parks and Recreation.

Partnerships

- EarlyOn staff were at the Fenelon Library for their **Skills for School** program each Thursday in June.
- The library has partnered with Salvation Army, Kawartha Lakes FoodSource, Community Living, HKPR Health Unit and the Dalton Community Centre to offer a weekly **Summer Lunch Program** at Dalton. Approximately twenty-five children will receive a free bagged lunch each week over the course of July and August. This is the second year this program has run.
